NOTES FOR THE NEXT MILLENNIUM

An exhibition of photographic work by senior Emily Carr College students will open at PRESENTATION HOUSE GALLERY on the evening of November 30th. Entitled **NOTES FOR THE NEXT MILLENNIUM**, the exhibition is intended to address some of the crucial issues on our minds as we enter the final decade of the 20th century, and rapidly approach the 21st: concerns related to the environment; cultural, gender identity; the significance of the family and its role in shaping our identity; human rights; and the all-pervasive effects of power and politics.

Work by the following nine artists make up the exhibition: Dianne Brehm-Cacchioni, Veronique Corne, Frank Gaudet, Robert Meister, Leslie Smith, Jerry Stochansky, Tracy Suter, Cheryl Withington, Jinme A. Yoon. The exhibition was selected by a three-person committee: Stan Douglas, Vancouver artist; Cate Rimmer, Curator of Artspeak Gallery; and Karen Love, Director/Curator of Presentation House Gallery. It was organized in cooperation with the Photography Department at Emily Carr College of Art & Design, and financially supported by the Leon and Thea Koerner Foundation in Vancouver.

NOTES FOR THE NEXT MILLENNIUM will continue in the Gallery to December 22. The gallery will be closed from December 22 to January 12, 1990.
