The Polygon Gallery Celebrates its First Anniversary with PAPER Gala & Art Auction

On Saturday, November 17, 2018 The Polygon Gallery celebrated the first anniversary of its new waterfront home in Lonsdale Quay with PAPER: First Anniversary Dinner and Auction.

Twenty art works were auctioned, with proceeds supporting The Polygon's artistic programming. The auction featured a diverse selection of photography, painting and mixed-media with works spanning the early 20th century to present day. Highlights included contemporary works by established BC Artists: Scott McFarland, Gordon Smith, Ron Terada, Melvin Williams, and Paul Wong; as well as works by emerging and mid-career talents: Maegan Hill-Carroll, Tiziana La Melia, and Theo Terry.

Vancouver-based artist Kevin Schmidt premiered a site-specific installation during the event entitled Reckless, a multimedia display festooning the exterior of the gallery with colourful LED lighting accompanied by a soundtrack composed by the artist. Schmidt's photograph Fog Study #2 (2004) opened the auction.

Swiss-based artist and book maker Batia Suter contributed one of the closing works for the auction, and is currently featured in a solo exhibition at The Polygon, Parallel Encyclopedia Extended.

The successful event welcomed 165 guests, raising \$250,000 that will help to sustain the upcoming year of exhibitions and educational programming in The Polygon's greatly expanded new space.
