**How much does it cost?** Free!

**What do I need in order to participate?** Internet access to attend online workshops, as well as a camera that shoots photographs and video. Phone cameras welcome.

**When are the workshops?** All seven virtual workshops will be on Saturdays: September 19, September 26, October 3, October 17, October 24, November 7, and November 21. Participants need to attend minimum four.

**What do I get out of the program?** A chance to exhibit work at an internationally reputed art gallery, and a \$250 artist fee! All participants will also receive a free iPhone tripod to be used during Response.

**Who can register?** Priority is reserved for Indigenous participants. Available spots will be made open to the public at the beginning of September. Participants should have an interest or practice in visual/ media arts.
