




Lot 1 I Xwalacktun, Eshlhihkw'iws, 2024

Skwxwú7mesh Master carver, Xwalacktun, is an internationally recognised artist who was born and continues to live on Skwxwú7mesh land, carrying with him the rich Coast Salish ancestries of his father (Skwxwú7mesh Nation) and mother (''Namgis Nation). He is an accomplished artist in wood, paper, stone, glass, and metal, and his public works are situated throughout Vancouver and the surrounding areas.

This stunning maquette was the core piece in the creation of a large public artwork installed at the Shape Centre master-planned community in Burnaby. Inspired by legends and the land, Xwalacktun incorporates 4 main components in this artwork: a thunderbird, which embodies the Coast Salish people; a salmon, highlighting the health of the land; water as the giver of life; and the eye, which remind us to be mindful of our actions. As the artist states, "We all share the same space in the universe. We all move together with the planet, so we need to work together to care for Mother Earth because Mother Earth looks after us."

Lot 4 I Jack Shadbolt, Jardin Noir, 1994

Jack Shadbolt (1909-1998) was a dominant figure in the Vancouver art scene beginning in the 1940s and is considered one of Canada's most important artists. His works are represented in major museums across Canada, including the National Gallery, and in many private and corporate collections.

Shadbolt drew from many sources of inspiration, including Cubism, Surrealism, American Regionalism, and Indigenous art, to help him express his deep affinity for nature and its cultural representation.

Jardin Noir is a suite of four lithographs with a multi-colour, abstract, floral, and garden theme. These bold and beautiful prints were created in collaboration with Artists for Kids, founded in 1989 with the intent to support art education. Jack Shadbolt worked alongside Gordon Smith, Bill Reid and other major Canadian artists to publish contemporary limited editions – which are now revered as some of the most significant limited-edition collections in Canada.
